Arms.—Gules, three pears or, on a chief argent a demi-lion passant sable, armed and langued of the first.
Crest.—A parrot vert, holding in the dexter claw a pear or, leaves proper.
Motto.—Aim at inventio.

Sir Edward Bindloss Perrott, 3rd Baronet (son of Sir Richard Perrott, 2nd Baronet, by Margaret Jemima his wife, dau. of Captain William Fordyce), Knight of Justice of the Order of St. John of Jerusalem in England, born 1 September 1784, bapt. 26 July 1787, baptism registered at St. Martin's Church, Charing Cross, in July 1787, fol. 508; died 24 March, bur. in St. Nicholas Churchyard, Plumstead, Kent, 31 March 1850.

Louisa Augusta, dau. of Colonel Nicholas Bayly, M.P. for Dover, 1st Foot Guards, brother of Henry, 1st Earl of Uxbridge; born 20 March 1779; marr. at St. Swithin's Church, Winchester, 20 May 1820; died 15 June, aged 51, bur. in St. Nicholas Churchyard, Plumstead, Kent, 22 June 1860.

Sir Edward George Lambert Perrott, 4th Baronet, Knight of Justice and Honorary Bailiff of the Order of St. John of Jerusalem in England, Captain East Kent Militia, born 10 May 1811, bapt. 1 September 1813, baptism registered at St. Marylebone Church, London; died 4 June, bur. at Old Charlton Cemetery, Kent, 8 June 1886. Will dated 3 July 1878, proved 23 October 1886.

Emma Maria, only dau. of Charles Evelyn Houghton, Commander R.N., grand-niece of Sir Hugh Evelyn of Wotton, Bart.; born 12 October 1810, bapt. at Chiswick 12 Oct. 1814; marr. at St. Luke's Church, Old Charlton, Kent, 13 October 1847; died 15 June, bur. at Old Charlton Cemetery 20 June 1878.

Henry Dive Perrott, born 31 July, bapt. 1 September 1813, baptism registered at St. Marylebone Church, London; died unmarried 23 June, bur. at Woolwich Cemetery 28 June 1889.

Richard Elington Perrott, born 9 December 1814, baptism registered at St. Marylebone Church, London; died 25 June, bur. at Woolwich Cemetery 28 June 1872.

Sir Herbert Charles Perrott, 5th Baronet, Major and Hon. Lieut.-Colonel 3rd Battalion "The Buffs" (East Kent Regiment); is a Knight of Justice of the Order of the Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem in England, and Chief Secretary of its Ambulance Department; formerly Assistant Secretary of the Order; born at Old Charlton, Kent, 26 Oct., bapt. there 9 December 1849.

Evelyn Edward Perrott of High Hodgfield, Durham, born at Woolwich 8 October, bapt. at St. Luke's Church, Old Charlton, Kent, 27 Dec. 1852.

Caroline Eleanor Fraser, dau. of Richard Matthews of Oatlands Park, Weybridge, Surrey; born 11 June 1835; marr. at St. Andrew's Church, Hove, Brighton, Sussex, 29 December 1881.

Fanny Augusta, born at Woolwich 28 April 1853, bapt. at St. Luke's Church, Old Charlton, Kent, two months after birth; died 19 January, bur. at Old Charlton Cemetery 24 January 1885.
