

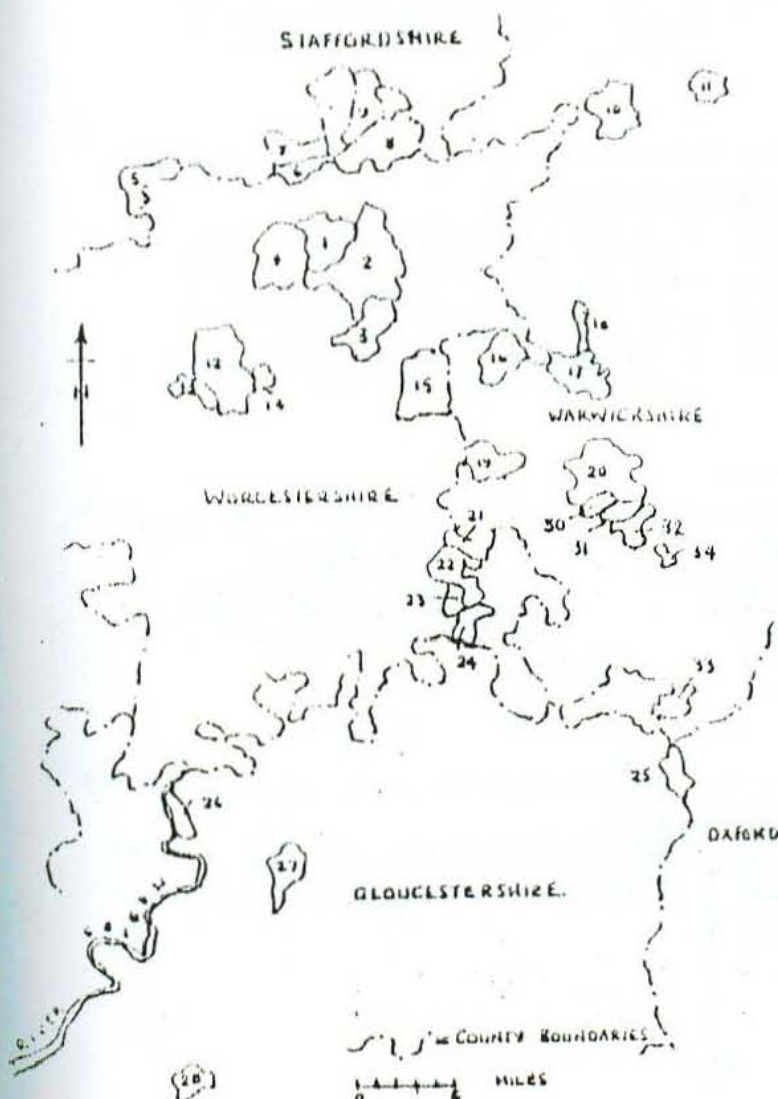
Member Pat McGlynn (No. 77.) has let me have a copy of a printed pedigree that has been in his family for some years concerning the Perrott family of Bell Broughton, Worcestershire. In the Winter Journal - page 57 - I printed the pedigree from the Rev. Barnwell's book 'Perrot Notes', and on page 58 the continuation of this line for the Somerset & Devon branch of the family. The pedigree that follows on the next few pages is much more detailed and the result of many years work by its compiler who had the means of travel and thus parish registers, wills etc to look at. We now have more information via the I.G.I. and the facility of purchasing from Record Offices etc, photocopies of wills that have now been deposited at one place.

To illustrate that if one gathers enough data together it is possible to extend an earlier printed pedigree, or a pedigree from the College of Arms, I have used this family as an example. Below you will see a map of the area concerned which I have extended to include our fertile basin in Gloucestershire around Nth Nibley and also show the location of Northleigh in Oxfordshire. Where there is space on the sheets I have used it to include data from the I.G.I. and a list of Wills that the Society has purchased. Although the facts and suppositions will follow in Part 2 & 3, there is one interesting fact that I will mention now as it could be a pointer to members whose descent is via Evenlode in Glos - once part of Worcs - or the area around.

I had noticed that the name of Humpirey occurs in this parish in the 1600's and as this is also a name connected with the parish of Bell Broughton, I wondered if there was any connection. From wills (details later.) the name of 'Walford' appears on those at Evenlode and Bell Broughton as witnesses or Inventory 'takers'. Perhaps a co-incidence but significant.

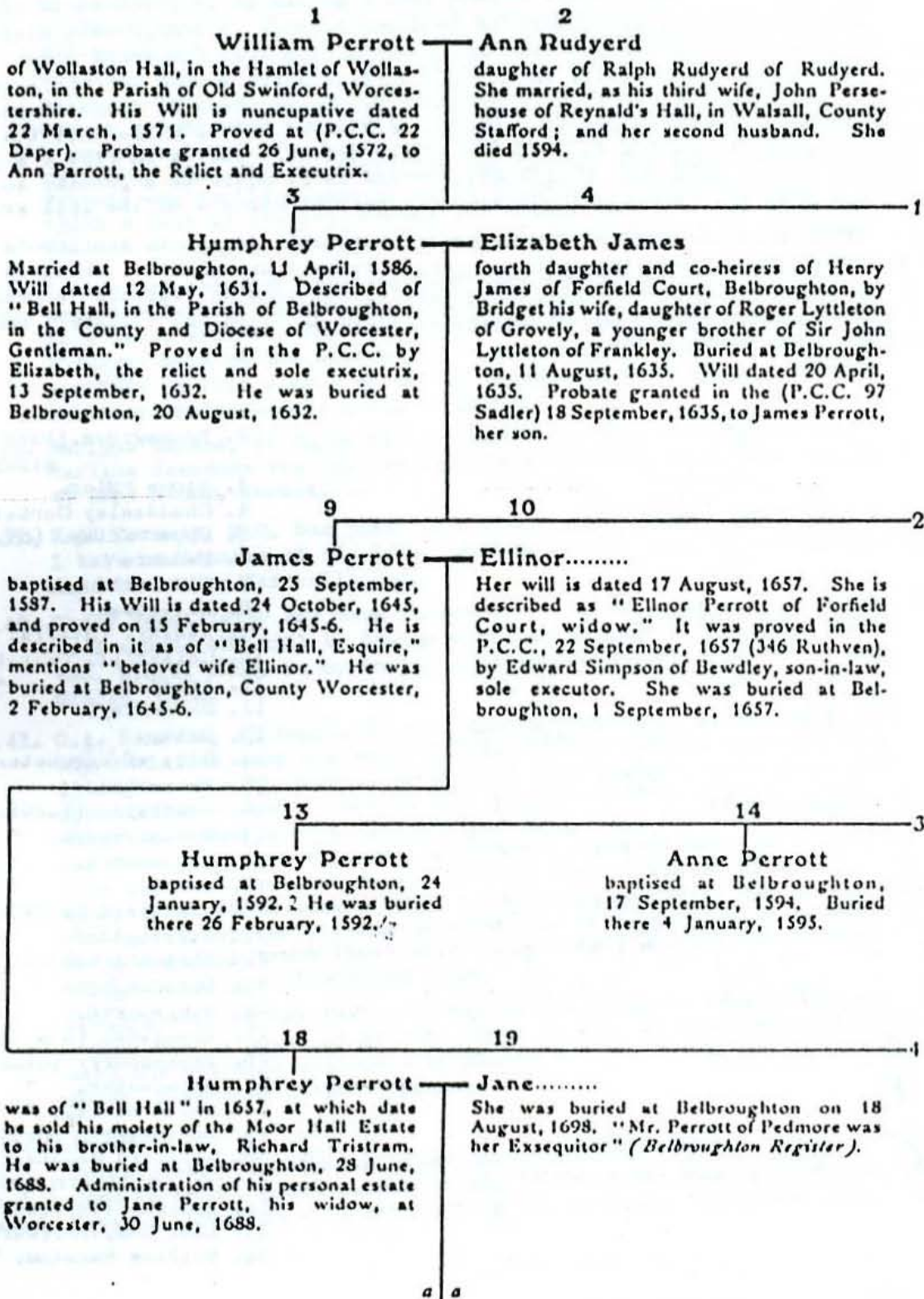

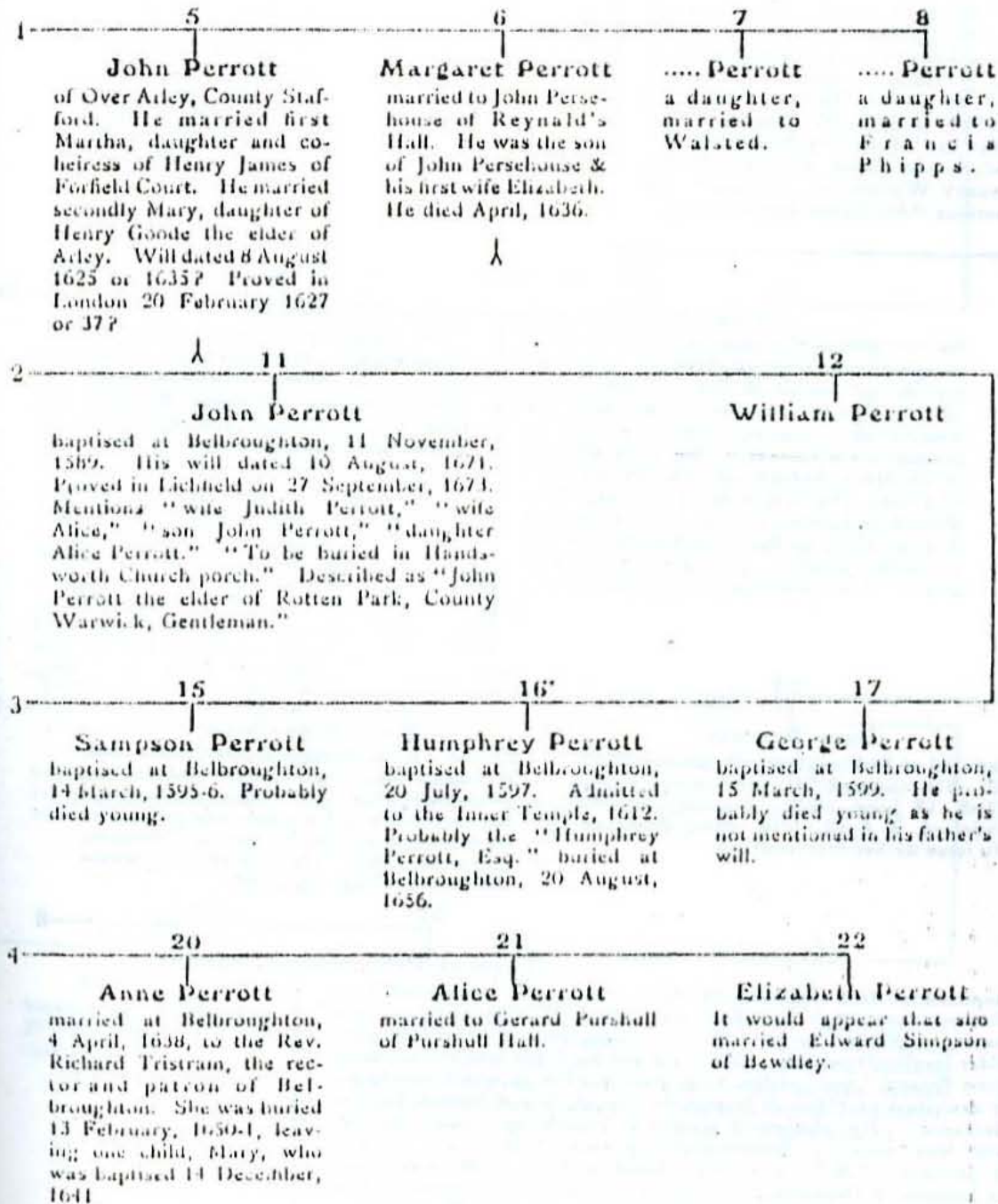

Setting forth the descents of the Family settled in Worcestershire from the earliest known date until their migration into the Counties of Somerset and Gloucester and the City of Bristol.



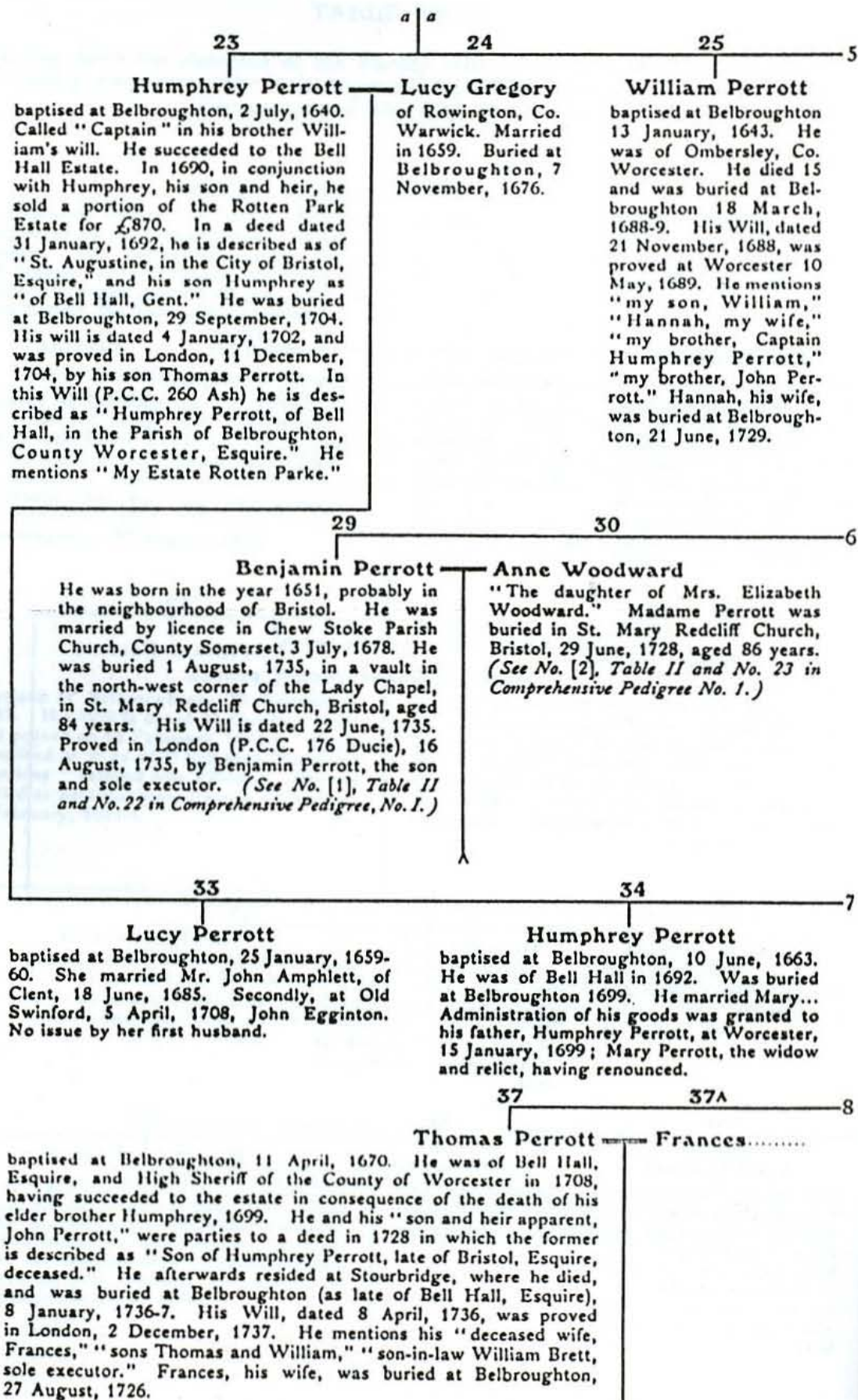

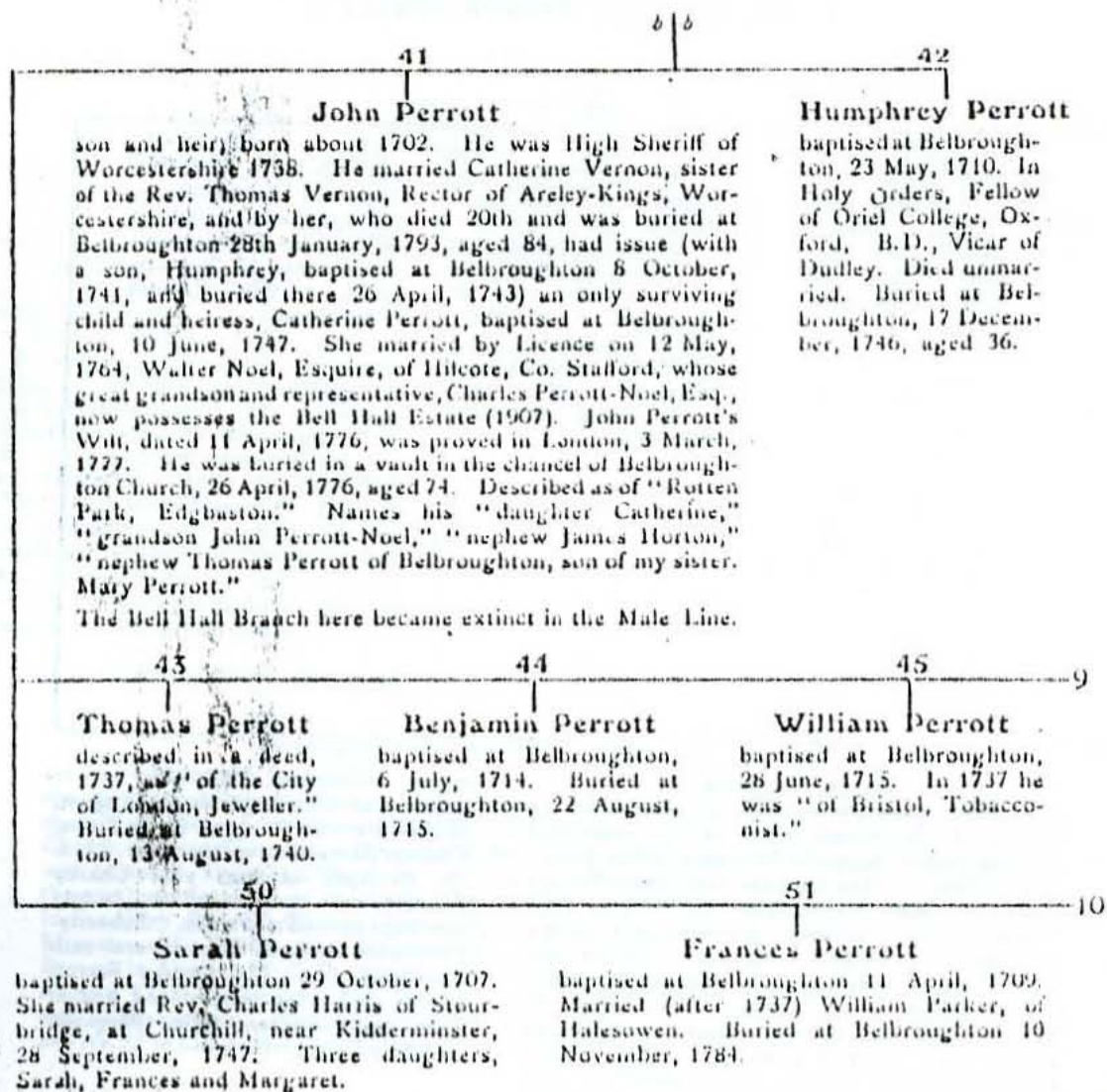

	<p><b>John Perrott</b> born 1653, probably in the neighbourhood of Bristol. 19 November, 1701, he was interested with his brother Benjamin in a case in the Tolzey Court, Bristol. "In the year 1696 John Perrott of Bristol, Gent.," purchased the Pedmore Hall Estate, County Worcester, where he took up his residence, and in about the year 1720 he was High Sheriff of that County. He was also Justice of the Peace for the same. He married, 27 August, 1713, at Broom, Mary Wheeler, as second wife. He died 8 March, and was buried at Belbroughton, March, 1728, aged 75. His first wife, Sarah, died December, 1711, aged 63, and was buried at Belbroughton, 26 December. John Perrott made his Will on 7 December, 1728.</p>	<p><b>George Perrott</b> baptised at Belbroughton, 24 August, 1659. He was living at Chew Stoke, County Somerset, in the year 1718. On 10 April of that year Charity Schools were commenced for twenty free boys to read and write. Subscriptions were obtained from several resident gentlemen; Mr. George Perrott giving £10. He married and had at least three children, John, Benjamin and Elizabeth.</p>

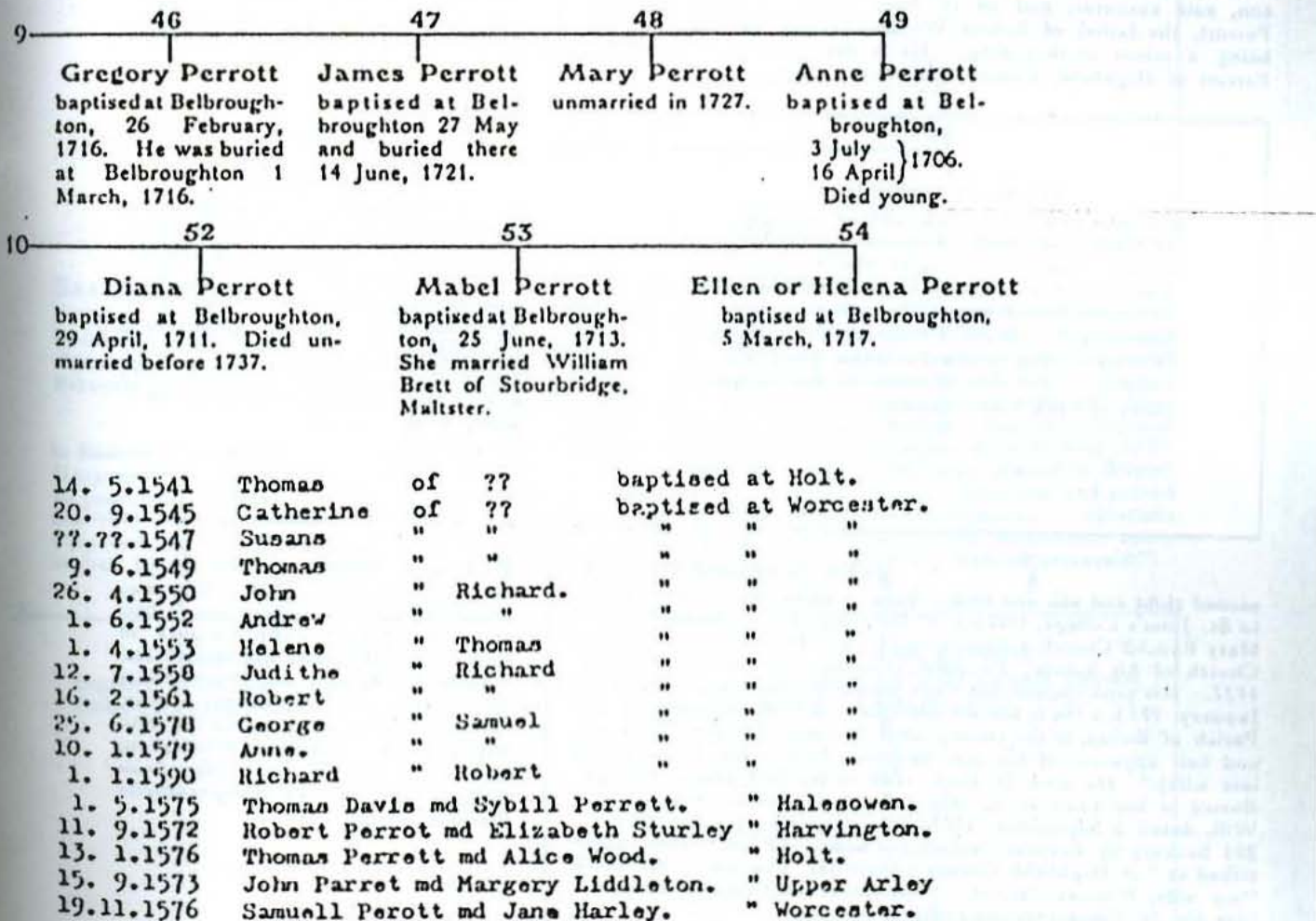

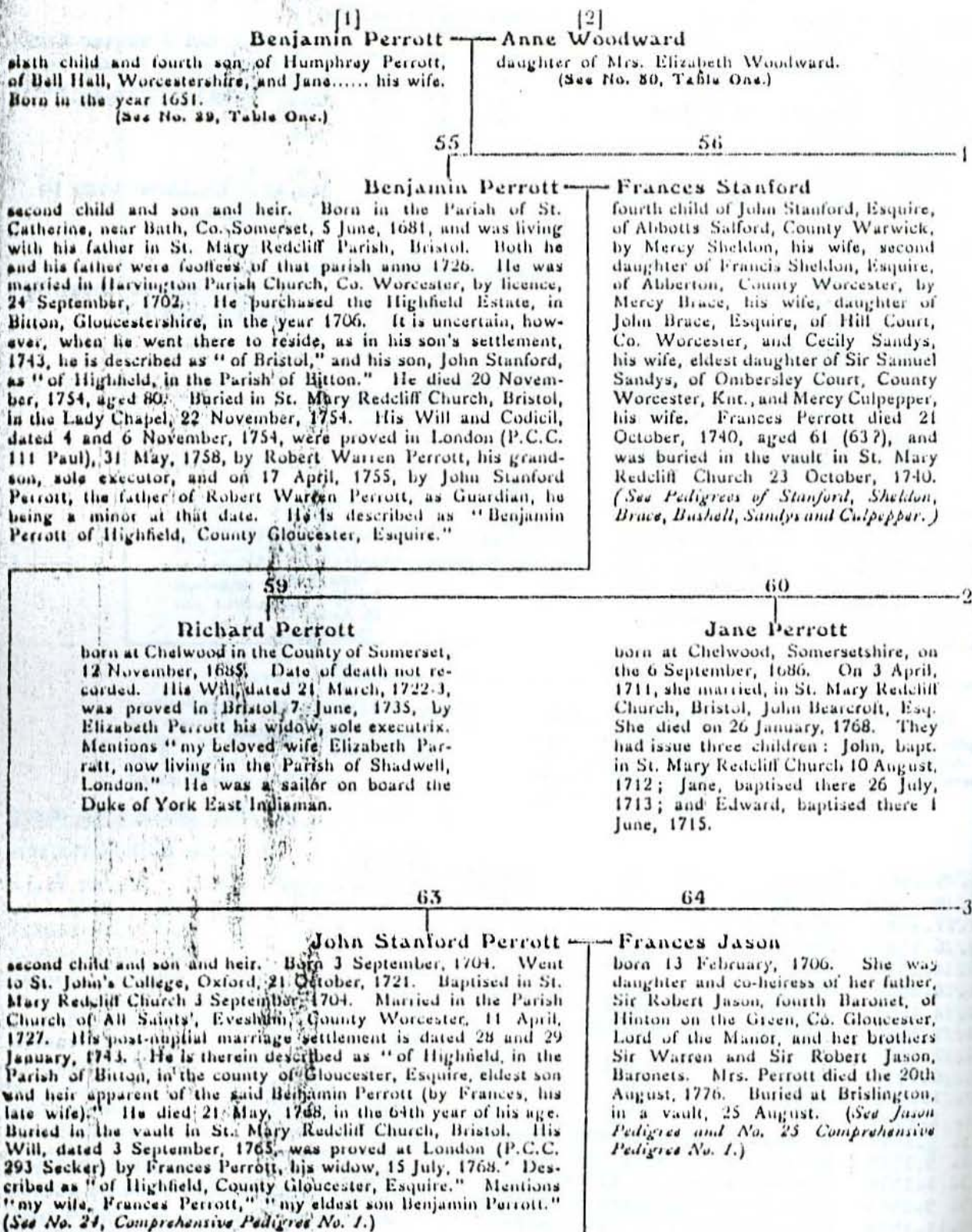

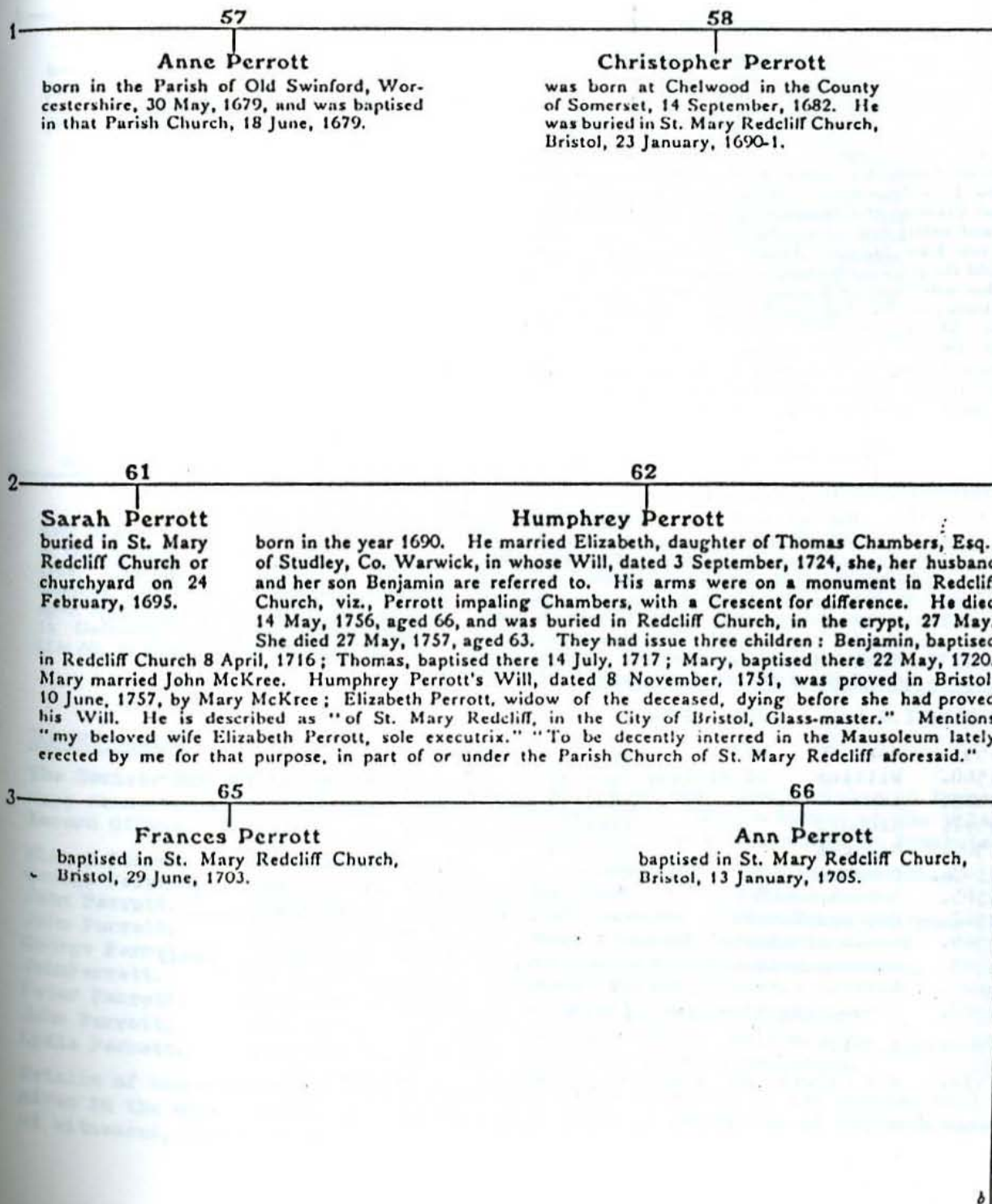

## Mercy Perrott

baptised in St. Mary Redcliff Church, Bristol, 9 March, 1706. She married Walter Webb, Gent., of Chew Stoke, Co. Somerset, and had a son, Benjamin Perrott Webb, a Remainderman in the settlement of the Highfield Estate. Also a daughter Mercy, who died 1758. Mercy Webb buried at Chew Stoke, 18 January, 1758.

## Jane Perrott

baptised in St. Mary Redcliff Church, Bristol, 12 February, 1709.

## John Stanford Perrott

fourth child and ultimate heir. Born 29 July, 1738. Married in Bitton Church, Gloucestershire, 11 June, 1772. He accompanied (with his wife) his mother and brothers into Devonshire after the sale of the Highfield Settled Estate under a Private Act of Parliament, in the year 1773-4. A portion of the proceeds arising from the sale was invested in the purchase of an estate called Easton, in the Parish of Chewton-Bishop, in the County of Devon; where this John Stanford Perrott resided. It was about eight miles from Crediton and twelve from Exeter, and contained one hundred and ninety-five acres. Some years later, in conjunction with his son John Stanford Perrott, the above John Stanford Perrott sold the property for two thousand two hundred pounds. He and his wife went to live in Exeter, where they both died. He was buried in the churchyard of St. Sidwell's in the City of Exeter, 30 January, 1820, aged 82. In a Will dated 4 November, 1801, but never proved, he is described as "of Hawkesbury Upton, in the county of Gloucester." Mentions "my good friends William Parker and John Bush," "my dear wife Elizabeth." (See No. [1] Table III.)

## Elizabeth Eddolls

The family of Eddolls resided for several years in the Parish of Brislington in the County of Somerset. She died in Exeter, and was buried in St. Sidwell's Parish Churchyard 25 April, 1830, aged 82. (See No. [2] Table III.)

## Katherine (Catherine) Perrott

born 11 April, 1733. Baptised at Bitton. Married James Holtbrook of Wick and Abson, in the county of Gloucester. She died at Upton, 3 September, 1780, aged 53, and was buried at Bitton. Her husband died 1781, and was buried at Bitton.

## Robert Warren Perrott

born 9 April, 1740. Baptised at Bitton 14 May, 1740. He was married at Bitton, 5 May, 1773, to Molly Eddolls. He died the 13th and was buried the 16th April, 1768 in the Walnut Parish Churchyard, near Bath, Somerset. They certainly had one child—if not more—"Frances Jayan Perrott, daughter of Robert Warren Perrott by Mary, his wife, was baptised at Brislington 24 April, 1774."

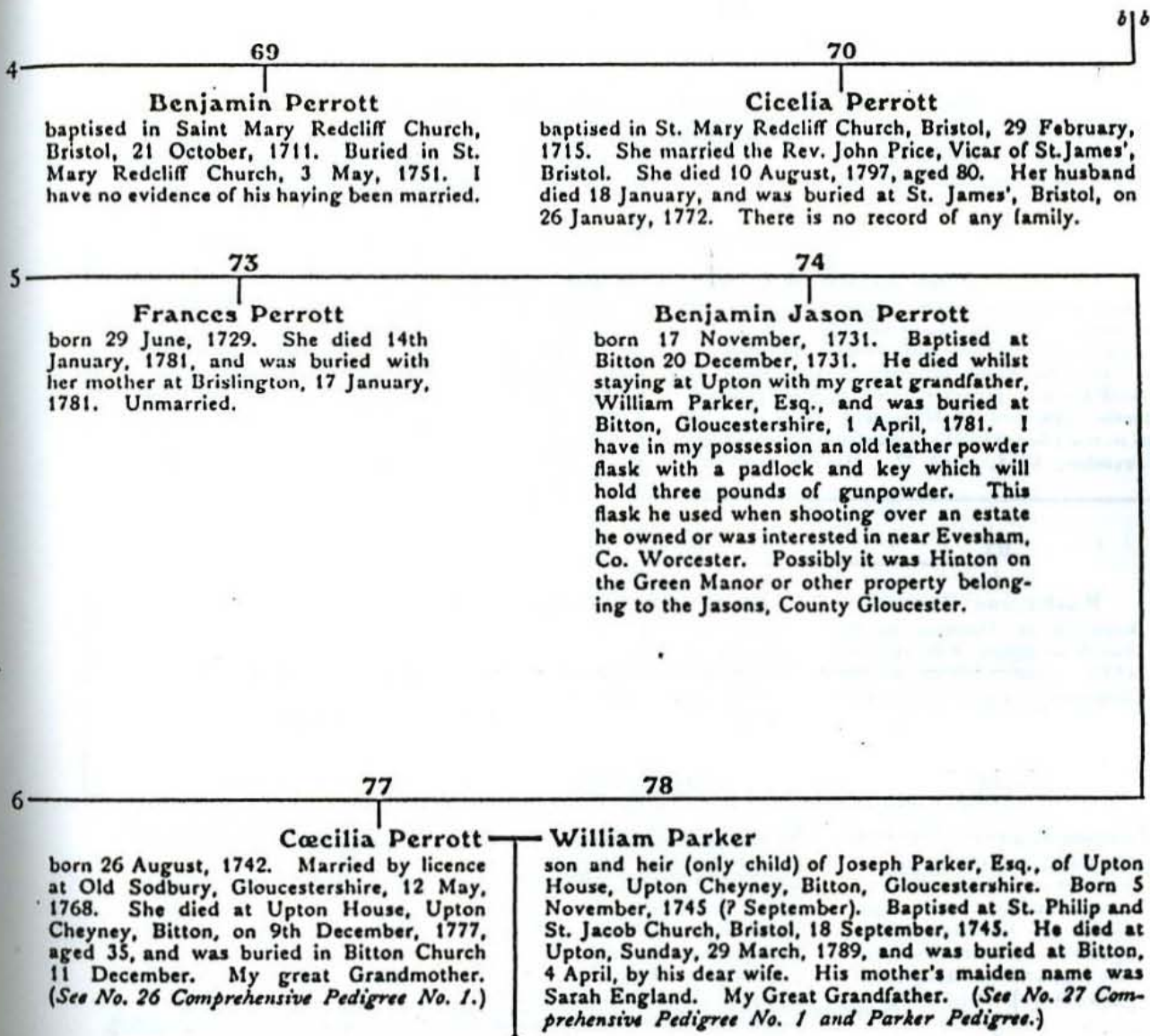

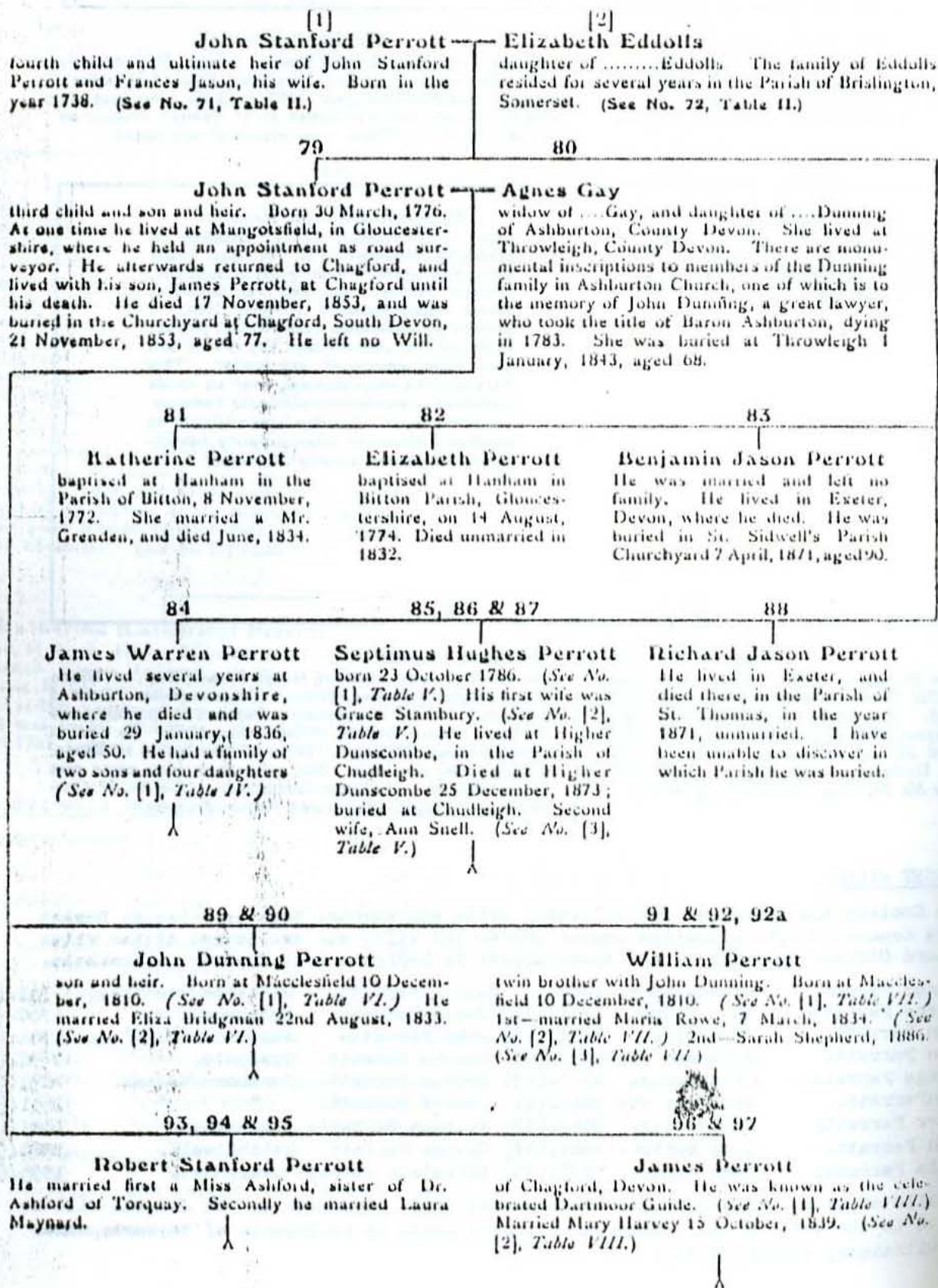

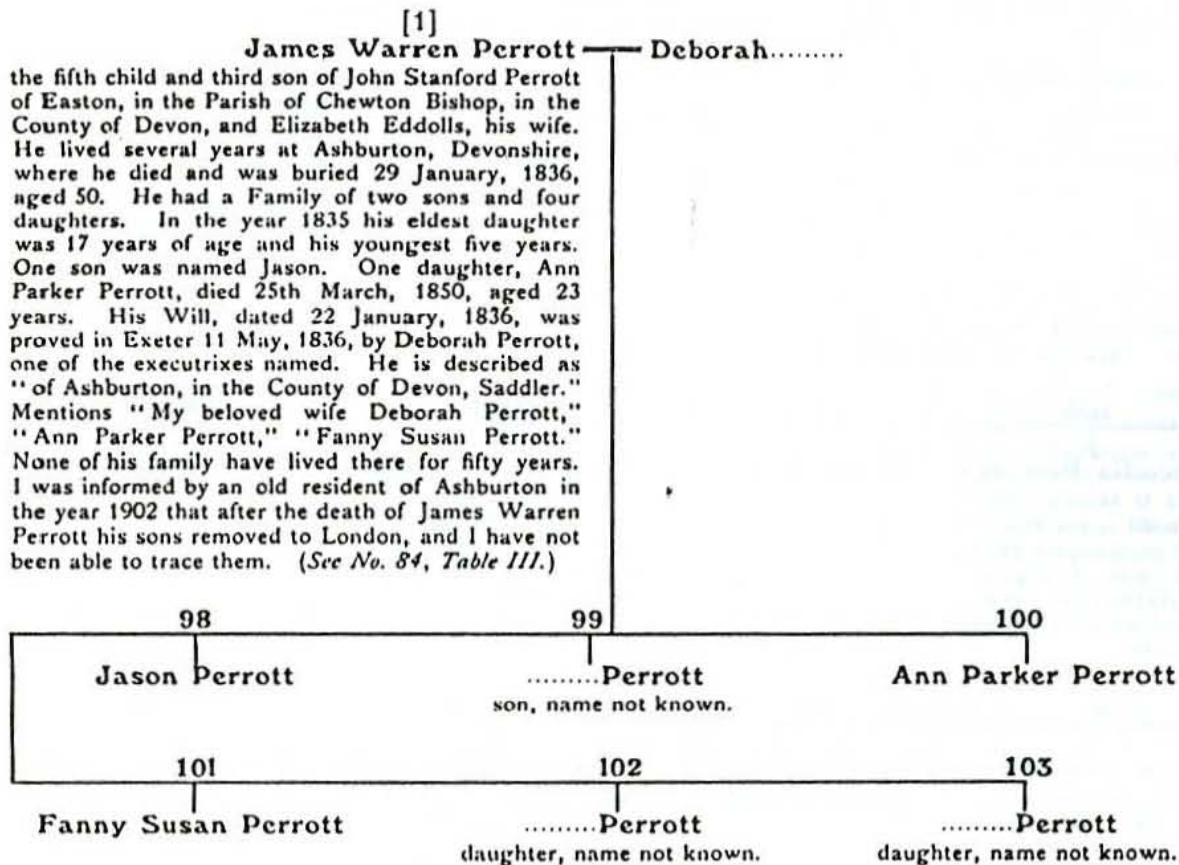
Showing the descents of the Family after they migrated from Gloucestershire into Devonshire.

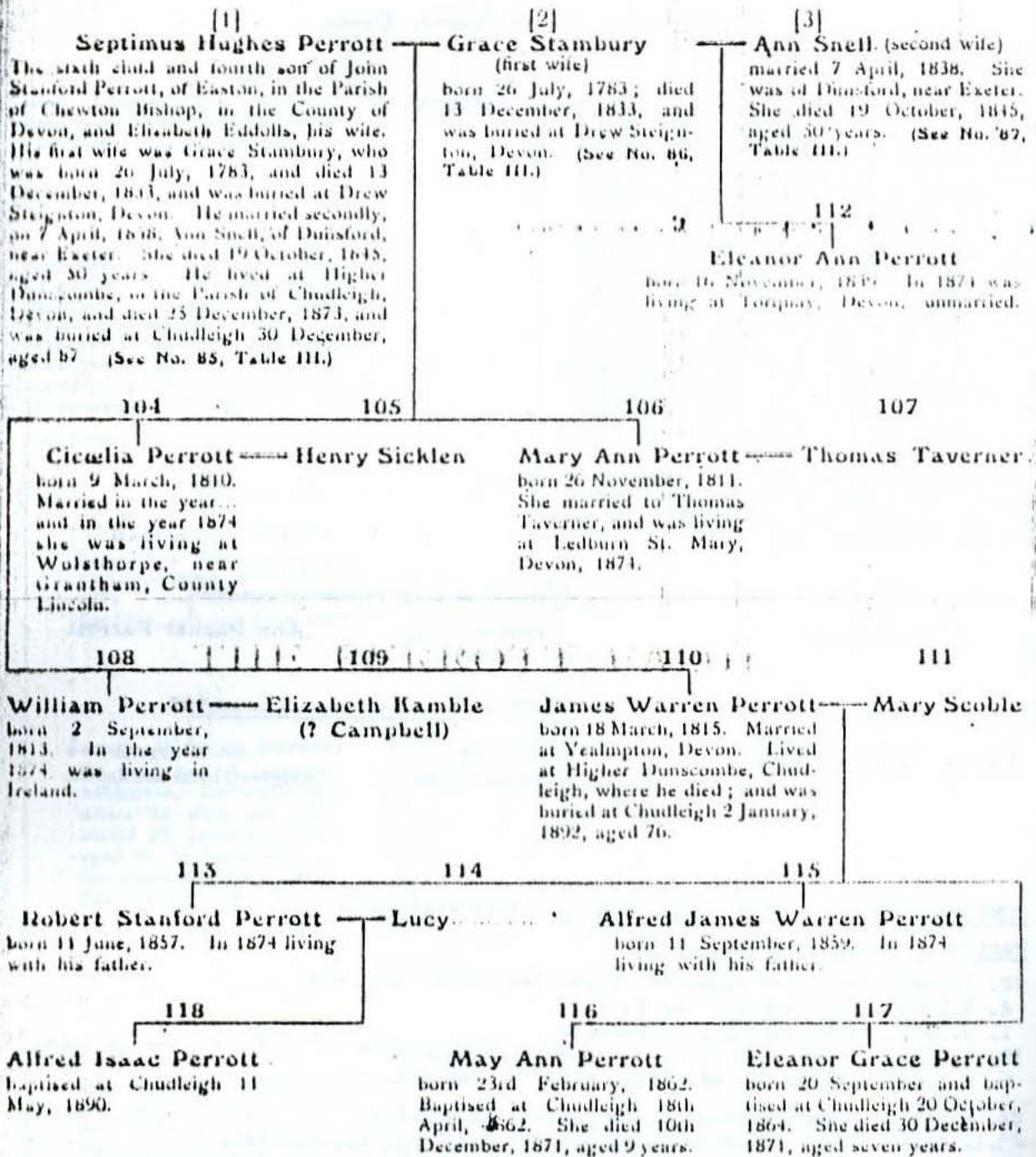
