 Dowdal, are hold and firmly bound unto his Excellency James Garrard
 esquire Governor of Kentucky in the sum of Three thousand Dollars Current
 Money To the payment of which well and truly to be made to the said
 Governor and his Successors we bind our selves our Heirs Executors and
 Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our
 seals and dated this third day of July 1798 The Condition of the
 above obligation is such that if the above bound James Norton as Sheriff of
 the County of Washington shall by himself or his Deputies, well and truly
 collect all Officers Fees and dues put into his or their hands to collect, and
 account for and pay the same at such times and in such manner as is
 directed by Law; shall also well and truly execute, and true returns make
 of all process and precepts to him directed, and to him or them delivered
 and pay and satisfy all sums of Money and Tobacco by him or them re-
 ceived, or which ought to have been received upon any such Process or precept
 to the person or persons entitled thereto and in all other things shall truly
 and faithfully execute and perform the said Office of Sheriff according to
 Law, during the time of his continuance therein then the above obligation
 to be void, otherwise to remain in full force
