Matton and Frances his Wife for and in consideration of the sum
of Forty Eight Pounds Currency of the State to them in hand paid by
the said Rhodum Parrot the receipt of which they the said
Matton and Frances does hereby acknowledge hath given granted bar-
gained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell
unto him the said Rhodum Parrot his heirs and assigns forever one
certain Tract or parcel of land containing by Survey one hundred and
nineteen Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at John Fremons corner a black Oak dogwood and large
Hicory in Ardains line with the same South Sixty Degrees East
Seventy One and half poles to two dogwoods and Sugar tree in said
